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Growing, however, challenges will be bigger.

We have ended up one more year, and since 2007 we have noticed a growth in terms of organs donation and transplants levels in our country, having almost reached our goals or targets. (10 donors pmp) we have got 9,9 effective donors pmp (an increase of 13,8% related to 2009), however, as we have used a brand new way of classification proposed by OMS, we truly have got 9,6 donors effective with transplanted organs

The notification index of potential donors 36,5 pmp has grown 6,7% and effective donation 3,5% having an increase of 10,3% related to indexes of effective donors last year with transplanted organs. In the potential donors notification we could say that some states have had a great performance such as Distrito Federal (77,4 pmp) and São Paulo (63,8pmp), followed by Espírito Santo (48,6pmp), Santa Catarina (47,9pmp) and Paraíba (47,8pmp), that most approached to the target for 2017 (50 pmp). None of these states reached the level of effectiveness proposed by OMS (40%) however Ceará (37,5%) and Santa Catarina (36,5%) most approached to it. Related to effective donors index with transplanted organs, São Paulo overcame 20pmp (21,2) followed by Santa Catarina (17,5 pmp). However, the states from the north part of Brazil need much more support on that in 2011 to modify this situation.

The index of kidney staffs (one to 1,4 million) Liver (one to 3,4 million) heart (one to 7,3 million) and pancreas (1 on to 16,2 million) my be right, while lungs (one to 47,7 million) is below average of necessity. However, having a deep analysis we could observe that the north part of Brazil has only 3 kidney transplantation staff (one for 5,3 million) and none of them for any other organ. Never the less, there is good news, in this region there were made kidney transplants with (dead donors) in Pará and Acre (with live donor). Another point that deserves attention and a future evaluation is that 1 to 1 transplants were made this year 40 of kidney staff (29%), 21 of Liver (38%), 7 of pancreas (41%) and 16 of heart (62%).

There were made 4,630 kidney transplants (close to the target of 4,800) an increase of 8% related to 2009, as 64,6% as dead donor the biggest ever reached. There was an increase of 17,2% in the transplant level with dead donor and a decrease of 5,7% live donor. Although all the restrictions to transplants with live donor unrelated another the level has increased lightly from 6,3% to 6,6% the greatest news is the

level of kidney transplantation of LIMITROFES donors (over 150) in states that do not make these transplants, and its allocation at Central Nacional, and in others states even being inferior to the estimative number of 600 kidneys per year, only 10% of the donors were over 600 years old São Paulo with 49,6 kidney transplants comes close to the estimate necessity for the country (70 pmp), followed by Santa Catarina (36,9pmp) and RS (36,6 pmp). Another fact to be considered is the high level indexes of live donors transplants such as in Paraná (17,9pmp) and in SP (21,1pmp), among the possible explanations are that these transplants were made with patients from different states/regions and its hard work in trying to find donors by these staffs in these states.

There were made 1,413 pancreas transplants (7,4pmp) that was close to the establish target of 1,500, there was an increase of 5,47% because of the numbers of transplants made with deceased donor of 8,2% and a decrease of 16,7% with lived donor. The indexes got by São Paulo state is extraordinary followed by (18,2 pmp) Santa Catarina (14,1 pmp) and Ceará (13,2 pmp) only these states could overcome the indexes of the transplants in 2010.

There was a failure in terms of heart transplants (17,4%), pancreas in its different categories (16,8%) and a stabilization in lungs transplants. Only Espírito Santo (2,3pmp) made more than 2 (heart transplants) this year. Related to pancreas and lung transplants only São Paulo (2,4pmp) and Rio Grande do Sul (2,6pmp) made more than 2 transplants pmp, respectively.

We would like to thank all staffs for sending update data and incomes for the goals of 2011 always remembering that our goal is to reach 100% of transplants we also ask to check the nº of transplanted patients under treatment, once the numbers in many quarters do not correspond to the nº of succeeded transplants finally, we have to do our very best to reach our goals in 2011 that is 11 to 12,5 donors pmp 5,200 kidney transplants 1,600 pancreas transplants and the improvement of other organs transplants therefore, this the greatest challenge that must be followed by those ones who really fight for that purpose.

Being the only which can offer its medical area benefits due to the investments made with public resources we still have to mention that as we are about to close to reach 2011 goals it is still missing the results of 706 of 4,630 of kidney transplants 101 of 1,413 liver transplants and only 2 of 60 lungs transplants.

We will have to mention that as we are about to close to reach 2011 goals it is still missing the results of 706 of 4,630 of kidney transplants 101 of 1,413 liver transplants, 7 of 166 of heart transplants and only 2 of 60 lungs transplants.

We will still go on motivating our staffs to do their very best in communicating the results of transplants and also put ourselves to help our transplant partners to give make suggestions that may help us to improve and reach this target.

We are on the right way to do that we are growing, and improving the nº of donation, graft utilization, nº of transplants and in our commitment to render the best services ever made to our society at all.





Annual evolution of organ transplants (absolute number)




Annual evolution of organ transplantation (per million population)



Annual evolution of Kidney transplants by donor type






Survival Curve (Kidney Transplantation)




Survival curves of patients and grafts in the period, include only the teams that reported 100% of their evolutionary.

Kidney transplants by state (absolute number)



Annual Evolution of liver transplants by donor type




Survival Curve (Liver Transplantation)



Liver Transplantation by state (absolute number)




Liver Transplantation by state (per million population)









Survival Curve (Pancreas after Kidney Transplantation)






Pancreas Transplants by State (absolute number)

Pancreas Transplants by State (per million population)





Survival Curve (Lung Transplants)








Lung Transplantation (per million population)




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
Annual evolution of transplants of cells (absolute number)



Annual evolution of cell transplantation (per million population)




Evolution of Bone Marrow transplants (by donor type)






Bone Marrow Transplantation by state (absolute number)




Bone Marrow Transplantation by State (per million population)



Annual evolution of tissue transplantation (absolute number)




Annual evolution of tissue transplantation (per million population)






Cornea transplants by state (absolute number)




Cornea Transplants by State (per million population)



Transplantation of Bone by state (absolute number)




Transplantation of Bone by state (absolute number)




Heart Valve Transplantats by state (absolute number)
